

League Tie Breakers

1. Head to Head competition. If the tied teams played 1 league game the winner of that game that the tied teams played is the winner of that position.
2. If they played more than 1 league game, whoever won the series would get the place.
3. If two league games were played and the team split, then we go to runs scored vs. run against in their games to determine the winner. Since we play a 10 run rule we only allow a difference of a maximum of 10 run per game.
4. If three or more teams are tied we look at all the team's record again each other. If one team lost to the others they are eliminated or if one team beat the other teams in head to head they will be declared for that spot.
5. If all tied teams have beat the other tied teams then we go to league run scored vs. league run allowed.
6. In all cases after runs scored vs. runs allowed if the teams are still tied we will have a coin toss or series of coin tosses to determine the winner of that spot.
7. If all league team have not completed their season by the last authorized play date of the league season, then all record for the league team will go by percent of won games vs. lost games.
8. If there are ties for 1st place in any league, all tied teams will be awarded League Championship honors regardless of their result again other tied teams.
